Sub: External threat to the honour and lives of the staff and children living on the campus of JNV SHOLAPUR –Reg.

We are deeply shocked and aggrieved to note the incident of dacoits breaking into the quarters of some our staff members of Jawahar Navodaya Vidylaya, Sholapur in the wee hours on 03-04-13. A few teachers and the vice-principal of the vidyalaya were brutally attacked and injured, and their valuables and money were looted. The whole incident lasted 30-45 minutes and the physical assault on the staff is beyond words. The unfortunate episode has brought to light the absence of security for the lives of the staff in Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya which are located in remote areas. The gruesome incident is more shocking as it has happened when the vidyalaya is running. Fortunately, the lives of the staff have been spared by the miscreants.

The AINVSA express its deep shock at the unfortunate episode in JNV, Sholapur and expresses its deepest sympathy for the staff who have undergone the traumatic experience. It prays for their quick recovery from the physical injuries they suffered and also hopes that they regain their mental strength soon to heal themselves of the wounds caused by the mental trauma.

At the same time, the AINVSA expresses its gratitude to Shri Divakar, Assistant Commissioner for paying a visit to the vidyalya on the same day to console the staff and learn about the attacks and looting first hand. We hope that the hon'ble officer will pay serious attention to the safety concerns of the staff and submit an appropriate report to the favourable attention of his immediate officers for an urgent suitable remedial action.

The AINVSA opines that this unfortunate episode should serve as a wakeup call for all, especially the NVS management. It should no longer ignore such external threats to the honour, lives and property of the 500 people living on the campus as well as the property of the vidyalaya. It should treat any attack on the inmates of the staff as an attack on the vidyalaya. Almost all vidyalayas are vulnerable to such attacks by virtue of their remote location. It is better to take suitable precautionary measures now otherwise we will all have to pay a heavier price for our leniency.
