Dear friends,

Sub: Request not to comply with Shri Mishra’s appeals

In continuation of our earlier letters related to the Pension Case coming up for hearing on 4th April 2013, we request the teaching and non-teaching once again not to comply with Shri Mishra’s appeal to send a filled-in vakalatnama and affidavit individually along with some more contribution to meet court expenses. In the same context we would like to bring to your kind attention the orders issued to Shri Sampath & Others.

1. All our three petitions have been attached to the older case of Shri T.M.Sampath and others, not to the Pune case as circulated by Shri Khannan, Shri T.P.Mani and others.
2. Shri T.M.Sampath and others (1-9) have got a favourable benefit for their pension case from hon’ble CAT, Delhi and the Delhi High Courts.
3. In connection with the same case some more petitioners (10-27) tried to file an SLP in the Hon’ble Supreme Court. But it has been dismissed by the Apex court on the grounds that **the applicants were not applicants before the Central Administrative Tribunal or the High Court** (orders enclosed).
4. **Since the thousands of vakalatnamas and affidavits we sent to Shri Mishra were not entertained by the Hon’ble Ranchi High Court, they will also be similarly dismissed by the Supreme Court.**

Hence, we appeal to the staff no to be mislead by Shri Mishra and others and waste their time and money in responding to their call. Please wait for more letters in connection with the case.
