Sub:-Conducting LDE to TGTs at all the Head Quarters of Regional Offices of NVS, regarding.

The AINVSA welcomes the belated announcement of the conduct of the Limited Departmental Examination for the promotion of some categories of TGTs to the post of PGTs on 24th November 2014 in Chandigarh. In this connection we request the Management to conduct the aforesaid examination at the **headquarters of all Regional offices** instead of one centre for the entire country on the following grounds:

1. Chandigarh is not ideally located for the conduct of a nation-wide exam as reaching it will compel the teachers to forego many of their leaves.
2. Making reservations is not easy at this juncture.
3. The distance of the test centre will discourage the lady teachers.
4. Conducting the exam at just one centre is not a sensible idea as any unforeseen event might adversely affect the conduct of the exam. It might also affect attendance of the promotion aspirants.
5. The teachers who attended the first limited departmental test in 2008 were put to great inconvenience as the **JNV, Chandigarh** which was at a stone's throw from the test centre was not alerted about the attending of thousands of the promotion aspirants. Their troubles were indescribable as the local lodges were already full.

The Association brought some of these problems to the notice of the **NVS** before the conduct of the second Limited Departmental Exam in 2009 and successfully impressed upon the management to change the test centre to the headquarters of the regional offices. But it is grieved to learn that the Management has decided to conduct the exam once again in Chandigarh. Hence, it requests the Management to reconsider its decision at the earliest to avoid causing inconvenience to the thousands of teachers.

The Association also requests the NVS to resolve the following issues connected with the promotion of the TGTs and the limited departmental examination:

1. Offering promotion to all TGTs who passed the first and the second limited departmental examinations but refused the posting for personal reasons before taking up the promotion of the third departmental promotion test qualifiers.
2. Preparing a wait-list of qualified TGTs and filling the vacancies that arise when the First List of qualified TGTs refuse the promotion offers.
3. Treating the Travelling period of the teachers attending the promotion test as duty period and paying them II class train fare on producing the attendance certificate.
4. Conducting the Limited Departmental Examination regularly every year in summer vacation
5. Delaying regular annual transfers till the vacancies are filled by promotional test qualifiers.
6. Stopping direct recruitment of PGT vacancies forthwith and filling the vacancies with in-service teachers.

We believe that the management would consider the above suggestions in the best interest of the **NVS** and its dedicated staff.
